The “Community House” assists low-income persons by providing basic services, connecting our neighbors to other organizations, and helping to improve life for all who live in Riverwood.

We serve the Riverwood community by providing:

- Supplemental food to prevent hunger (every 30 days)
- Hygiene supplies to address health and sanitary issues
- Bus tokens to help our clients acquire or maintain benefits, maintain or obtain housing, keep critical appointments, and address legal concerns (proof of use will be required)
- Use of business equipment including copier, fax machine, phone, & a computer lab to help our clients seek jobs, complete school assignments, pay bills, & more
- Referrals to other resources
- One-Stop Social Service Center that brings additional community services to Riverwood
- Meeting or gathering space

Our Services:

- Food Pantry:
 - Monday – Thursday from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
 - 1st & 2nd Wednesday from 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm for people who are working or in school
- Emergency food by appointment with referrals from the Red Cross, Salvation Army, Police, or Fire Department
- Senior Servings, 1st & 3rd Fridays, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm *
- Veterans Servings, 2nd Friday, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm *
- Hygiene, Monday – Thursday from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
- Business Center, Monday – Friday, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
- Bus Tokens, Monday – Thursday, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm

Qualifications: To receive services, neighbors must complete an application, provide identification, and proof that they live in Riverwood (51st to 71st / Riverside to Lewis). We do serve several census tract areas near the boundaries of Riverwood.

Our In-House Partners

Emergency Infant Services (EIS): EIS provides diapers, wipes, and formula to clients with children up to 5 years of age at the STCH every Thursday (except holidays) from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm. Call EIS for additional information at 918-582-2469.

Legal Aid Services of Oklahoma: Free civil legal services are provided to persons in the Riverwood area. Drop by STCH (Monday – Friday, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm) to meet with or schedule an appointment with the attorney. Call 918-238-2049 for more information.

Improving Lives Counseling Services: Case Managers are at STCH Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, 9:00 am - 1:00 pm. They work with clients to acquire services, reduce barriers, and achieve goals. Professional counseling is also available for persons with private insurance, SoonerCare, or Medicare.

St. John's Medical Clinic: Adult and child primary care services offered including maternity care. The clinic is open Monday and Friday, 1:00 – 5:00 pm / Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 8:00 am – 12:00 pm. The entrance is located in the rear of the building on the NW corner. Call St. John Clinic at 918-710-4272 for more information and to schedule an appointment.

TRIO/Educational Opportunity Center (TRIO/EOC): TRIO works to help people obtain their GED and go to any college. They are onsite once a month on a Tuesday. Their schedule changes so contact John Thao at 918-595-8602 to find out when he will be at STCH next.

Tulsa Health Department: Maternal Child Health Outreach team member offers enrollment and renewal assistance with SoonerCare/SoonerPlan for pregnant women, parents of minor children and their children. Outreach also provides referrals for WIC, parenting classes and immunization records. Available at STCH on Mondays 9:00 am – 1:00 pm. Call 918-595-4273 for more information.”

Union Adult Learning Center High School Equivalency (HSE) Classes: UALC provides Community HSE classes on Tuesday & Thursday, 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm. Classes are provided for adults who are no longer attending high school and need basic skills instruction in reading, writing, math, and life skills. To register for a class, show up at 5:00 pm and meet with the teacher. Call 918-357-7040 for more information.
